# 5.1 Joanne Yellapa, Coordinator of Performance Measures and Special Projects – Service Area Update

Joanne Yellapa provided the Board with an overview of the Library's performance measures and ongoing projects, noting increased in-person Branch visits and a 19% rise in Social Return on Investment (SROI) through the Valuing Ontario Libraries Toolkit (VOLT). Joanne shared benchmarking data against comparator Library systems and reported that the Library has received a total of \$190,669 in grant funding since 2020, supporting space enhancements, innovation, and initiatives including the Library Strategic Master Plan.
