Ajax Public Library Expands Services in Red Zone

17 February 2021—Ajax Public Library is offering computer access and study spaces, while continuing to offer curbside pick-ups for Library materials as Durham Region moves into the Red-Control zone.

Beginning on February 23, the Library will permit customers in-branch computer access and study space use by appointment. All three locations are available Tuesdays through Saturdays, from 9:30 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Access to computers and study spaces can be booked by contacting the Library via phone, email, or their chat service. Customers are asked to limit their visits to a maximum of two hours to ensure others have opportunities to use the space.

Protocols such as active screening at Library entrances, increased cleaning, time limits, and masking and distancing requirements are all in place to help keep customers and staff safe.

The Library continues to offer extensive virtual services, collections, and programs, as well as curbside and pedestrian pick-up options. Not a Library customer yet? No problem – you can sign up online for an eCard for instant access.
