
Book Club Guide: Being a Critical Reader



Before You Begin Your Book

- · What does the title tell you about the book?
- Do you know anything about the book already, and has it created preconceived ideas?
- Consider keeping a reading log! Track your progress, sections you want to discuss with your group, or thoughts or feelings you have as you read.

While You Read

- Make note of exciting or confusing passages for discussion.
- Look up words or phrases that you're unsure of reading expands your vocabulary!
- Do you have any guesses about the outcome, and do they change as you read?

After You Finish the Book

- How do you feel about the ending?
- What did you like best or least?
- Did you feel engaged in the story or did you struggle to finish?
- Did you learn anything new or gain a new perspective after reading this book?
- · Would you change anything about the book?
- Would you read another book on this topic or by this author?
- Would you recommend this book to a friend? Why or why not?

The Setting

- Was it a realistic atmosphere?
