Book Club Guide: Member Etiquette



Participating in Discussion

- Observe regular courtesies such as being on time, setting your devices to silent, and introducing yourself to new members.
- Read the book! Even if it's not your preferred genre or style, give it a chance.
- Different opinions, positive and constructive alike, make for engaging discussion. Be sure to be respectful of other opinions in your conversation.
- Avoid side conversations and do not interrupt others who are speaking. Make sure
 your group has a mechanism for who speaks next if needed.
- Keep on topic, but introducing relevant contextual information can be helpful.
 This could include historical facts from that time period, biographical details about characters or authors, etc.
- Bring your notes if you have them, and share quotes or page references.
- Have fun!

Tips for Moderating and Leading

- Prepare questions in advance. This can be done by writing them as you read, or searching for generic or title-specific book questions online. See our Book Club Discussion Guides or Book Club Guide: Being a Critical Reader!
- Promote discussion and equal speaking time. Outline the mechanism for waiting to speak in advance (ex.: raising a hand), and make sure that everyone who wants to speak has an opportunity to.
- Give people time to think about responses a few moments of quiet to think is okay!
- Keep discussion on topic. New information and tangents can be welcome, but respect everyone's time and those who came to discuss the reading.
- Consider starting or ending with a round table, giving an opportunity to everyone to summarize their opinions or rate the book on a shared scale.
